In 2004 he founded the design company Salto & Sigsgaard with Architect Thomas Sigsgaard, working mainly in the field of product design, lighting – and interior.

MATERIAL

Shell: The shell has a high gloss back and the front has a matt finish with ripples. The chair is also available with seat upholstery which can be mounted upon delivery or purchased separately.

Base: The base is available in 14 mm steel tubes (powder coated in colours matching the shell or chromed) and in natural oak veneer legs. The sled base as well as the bar and counter stool are only available with legs in chromed steel. To minimise undesired noise and the risk of floor marks, the front and back leg ferrules have different sizes on the 4-legged versions in steel. The leg ferrules are made of black TPE.
